

## Explanation of RoHS 2 (Directive 2011/65/EU and regulation governing electrical media)

Dear Sir or Madam,

Thank you for your inquiry concerning RoHS 2 (Directive 2011/65/EU or the electrical and electronic equipment ordinance).

We are more than happy to provide the following explanation:

1. We constantly monitor the statutory substance restrictions governing electrical and electronic equipment pursuant to Directive 2011/65/EU of 8 June 2011 and maintain a quality assurance system (QM system) to support you as a manufacturer when it comes to compliance with the requirements of the new electrical and electronic equipment ordinance in force since 9 May 2013.
2. Based on this QM system and our present level of knowledge, we assume that the maximum concentration values for lead, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, PBB, PBDE and mercury listed in the electrical and electronic equipment ordinance have not been exceeded in the components supplied by us. Should we, despite this QM system and contrary to expectations, become aware of an exceeding of these limit values, we will inform you immediately.
3. Items 1 and 2 also apply to regulations in other EU member states for implementation of Directive 2011/65/EU which correspond to the electrical and electronic equipment ordinance.
